Our team is seeking two Public Works Summer Labourer positions reporting directly to the Operations Supervisor. This position will be responsible to assist the Public Works department as required with a variety of duties related to water, sewer, natural gas, roads, streets, and green spaces including:

- Maintenance duties on roadways, lanes, sidewalks and parks
- Erecting and maintaining signage
- Maintenance duties on parks as required (including grass cutting and weed whipping)
- Operating and servicing Town equipment as required
- Cleaning of debris where required
- Working outdoors at various work sites
- Following the Town of Redwater Health and Safety Program Guidelines

Qualifications

- Must be between the ages of 18 and 30 years old to be eligible for this *Canada Summer Jobs* position.
- A *Canada Summer Jobs National Priority Initiative* is to remove barriers to employment for youth, applicants are encouraged to self-identify in their cover letter if they are underrepresented in the labour market such as Black and other racialized youth, Indigenous youth, 2SLGBTQI+ youth.
- Valid Class 5 Motor Vehicle Operators license and driver's abstract required
- Criminal Record Check is required
- Experience with the operation of equipment an asset
- Effective verbal and written communications skills
- The ability to work well in a team atmosphere as well as alone with little to no supervision
- Physical capabilities including lifting, twisting, and walking
