## Leader In Training (L.I.T.)

*Temporary Summer Volunteer Position  
(July/August: 15-40 hours/week)*

We are focused on creating a healthy community and enhancing the quality of life for our residents by offering safe, inclusive, and affordable quality recreation experiences. Whether it's making slime with participants, splashing in the pool, or reading a story – this is YOUR opportunity to be involved for the summer. This volunteer position is an opportunity to enhance leadership and general employability skills. The (6) L.I.T. positions will work alongside with experienced programmers that will teach the basics for providing quality recreation experiences for the community. If successful, applicants will receive a Town of Redwater uniform, a reference letter (at the conclusion of the summer), and a certificate of recognition to be presented at council meeting in September.

Reporting to the Community Services Summer Staff.

- Participate in mandatory pre-program training (3:30-5:30pm, June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022)
- Assist in inclusive programs to children, youth, and families.
- Support a fun, positive, safe atmosphere at Redwater Summer Programs
- Support the safety of all individuals through active supervision of participants and by following organizational policies and procedures, COVID-19 protocol, and promoting inclusive behavior
- Act as a support staff for children/youth programming
- Maintain timesheet for recording hours
- Work in a variety of locations and weather conditions such as indoors, outdoors, onsite, and offsite for a variety of parks services, programs, events, and potential fieldtrips

### Qualifications:

- Must be between the ages of 13 and 17 years old to be eligible for this program position
- Experience in working with children and youth is an asset
- Babysitters Safety course is an asset

Up to a maximum \$600 honorarium, based on total working hours will be paid at the end of the summer. Hours of work will vary and may include daytime, evening, and weekend shifts to meet work goals. Applications for the six positions are due by May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 3:30pm.
