## VISITING HOURS

The Cemetery is open to the public seven days a week from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.

For questions regarding the location of a grave site, you may contact the Town Office during normal business hours at (780) 942-3519.

## LOCATION

The Cemetery is located a short distance east of Town on Secondary Highway 644 (48th Avenue).

The Cemetery entrance is just south of the intersection of Secondary Highway 644 and Range Road 214.

Limited parking is located just inside the Cemetery gates; parking outside the Cemetery is discouraged except for during services.

## CEMETERY PLOTS

Plots in the Cemetery are available for full casket burial and cremation urns. The Cemetery is non-denominational and available to both residents and non-residents.

One individual may pre-purchase a maximum of four Plots, Niches, or any combination thereof, at any one time.

Each Plot can contain either:

- One full casket and three cremation urns, provided the full casket precedes the cremation urns

or

- Four cremation urns

Temporary Markers, usually supplied by the funeral home, may be installed for up to two years following interment, after which time a Permanent Marker must be installed.

Concrete liners or vaults are a mandatory requirement for full casket burials; these items are usually obtained directly from the funeral home.

## COLUMBARIUM

A Columbarium is a freestanding above ground structure with Niches to hold cremated remains.

The Columbarium is granite faced, suitable for engraving.

Two urns of average size can fit in one Niche space.



## FLORAL DISPLAYS

Cut flowers, wreaths, and floral pieces may be placed on graves. The Town will remove these items once their condition deteriorates.

Please do not plant any of your own trees, hedging, shrubs, woody ornamentals, flowering ornamentals, or bulbs in the Cemetery.

For safety of visitors and staff, placing any fences, cooping, landscape rock, vases, candles, or other personal mementos is not permitted.

## MARKERS

Markers for burial and cremation plots may be ordered through a funeral home or directly with a monument company. Markers should be made of granite, bronze, brass, or marble.

Permanent Markers must be either flat or have a flat foundation allowing for at least five inches around the Marker base.

Markers can only be installed after making application to the Town and paying the Marker Permit fee.

## NICHE COVERS

The purchase of a Niche in the Columbarium includes the supply of one granite Niche Cover. Upon application and payment of the Marker Permit fee, Niche Covers may be engraved with lettering and designs.

The Inurnment right-holder is responsible for all costs associated with engraving the Niche Cover.

### Interment Services, Cremation Urn

Open/Close (May 1 – Oct 31)..... \$ 250

Open/Close (Nov 1 - Apr 30) ..... \$ 350

After hours surcharge\* ..... \$ 150

Perpetual Care ..... \$ 100

The Perpetual Care Fund has been established to cover the future maintenance costs of the Cemetery and is charged on all Interment and Inurnment services.

### COLUMBARIUM NICHE

Single Niche ..... \$ 400

### Inurnment Services

Open/Close ..... \$ 250

After hours surcharge\* ..... \$ 150

\*After hours surcharges will be added to any opening/closing activity that occurs outside normal business hours, on weekends, or statutory holidays (in accordance with Section 6.7 of the Cemetery Bylaw)
