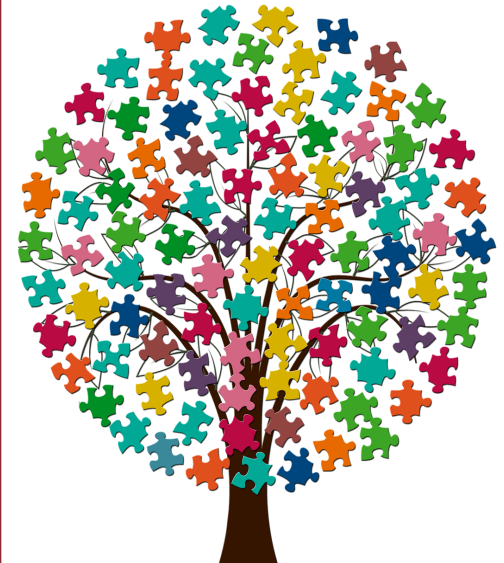

The Town of Redwater endeavours to provide recreational, social and cultural programming in support of a healthy, viable and vibrant community.

Recreation Facilities

Pembina Place, our state of the art facility, boasts an indoor ice arena, outdoor rink, curling club, golf club, and our Community Cultural Centre, for a variety of recreational and community uses.

Family & Community Support Services (FCSS)

Through a funding partnership with the Alberta Government, we offer a variety of preventive social programs and events that enhance the well-being of individuals, families and our community.

FCSS programs offered by the Town of Redwater Community Services include Leaders in Training (youth ages 13-17), Babysitter Safety, Home Alone, Community Connections, parent education and support seminars, community development workshops for local community groups, and seniors workshops. Programs offered vary from year to year based on community needs.

Additionally, through the FCSS Program offered by the Town of Redwater, residents are able to access information on personal support services or resources in the Redwater area and may also be referred to local, regional or provincial human service agencies.

Community Events

Throughout the year, we partner with local community groups and organizations to offer a variety of events.

Family Day of Fun

An afternoon of fun, family-friendly activities to help you connect with family and the community.

Volunteer Appreciation

An annual evening to honor and celebrate the accomplishments of our community volunteers.
