#### **Pre-authorized Payment Plan**

You can sign up anytime to have your utility bill amount withdrawn directly from your bank account. Payments are collected on the 20th day of each month or the next business day.

#### FLOOD MITIGATION WORK

As per direction by Council, the flood mitigation work will start by mid September. Gradall, a third party contractor has been retained to clean up and grade the drainage ditches starting with the ditch along the CN track south of Cedarwood Condos and Paradise Inn Hotel. This work will increase the storm drainage capacity. Future development can commence with the knowledge that infrastructure damage due to flooding will be reduced and/or eliminated.

Replace your old, water guzzling toilet with an efficient, dual flush or low flush (4.8-litre or less per flush) toilet and you are eligible for a rebate of \$50. Replacing your high-volume toilet could also save you over 1000 litres of water each month, putting money back in your pocket.

Your old toilet will qualify if it currently uses 13 litres of water per flush (or more). There may be a stamp on the inside or rear of the tank that indicates the litres/flush. If you cannot find a stamp, calculate the *flush volume* by multiplying length (cm) x width (cm) x water depth (cm) divided by 1000 = volume of flush in litres.

To apply for this rebate, complete the application form and submit to the Town Office with your receipt that indicates a dual flush or low flush model. The rebate is available to Town of Redwater residents only.

Rebates are processed on a first come, first served basis and there will be a maximum of 20 applications processed per year and a limit of one rebate per household.

#### **ORGANIC BIN PICK UP**

Residents are advised that the last day for pick up of the organic waste bins is Friday, **November 6, 2020**.

Pick up of organics will resume again in spring of 2021.




