Pie Plates and Containers



Cardboard - Flattened



Mixed Paper/Paperboard
(e.g. Magazines, flyers, newspaper, Catalogues, Office Paper, Envelopes, Craft Paper, Books with front and back cover removed)



Wrapping Paper
Greeting Cards
No Foil, decorations removed

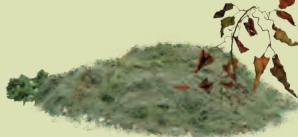
