The program will run **October 1 - December 1**. Derrick Dollars may be used until **December 7**.

Participating retailers will award Derrick Dollars to random customers who are wearing masks and/or following sanitization protocols. Customers can redeem their Derrick Dollars at any participating store when making a minimum purchase of \$5 and can use up to 5 Derrick dollars per purchase.

Halloween Safety Tips

Halloween is just around the corner. Let's celebrate the spookiest time of year without the fear of spreading COVID-19.

- Don't go trick-or-treating or hand out candy if feeling ill, even if symptoms are minor.
- Avoid touching doorbells or railings: call "trick or treat" from 2 metres away, knock instead of using doorbells, use hand sanitizer after touching surfaces.
- Minimize contact with others: trick-or-treat with your family or cohort, remain within your community, and stay 2 metres apart.
- Wash hands and disinfect packages before eating candy.
- Wear a non-medical mask that fully covers your nose and mouth.

As part of an ongoing effort to find efficiencies and savings, please be advised that the Town will be using a contracted service provided by Municipal Planning Services (MPS), who currently provides planning assistance to the Town.

Development Permits are available online in a pdf-fillable format, or from the office. Enquiries can be sent by email, by telephone or by appointment.

MPS will be at the Town Office once a week to meet with prospective applicants with questions.

Safety Codes permitting, which includes building, electrical, plumbing and heating will continue to be provided by the Inspections Group.

Such a change will result in significant financial savings for the Town, while having knowledgeable personnel available to assist you.
